

# 2009 NJIFA Cetrulo Boys' Relay Championship

Entry to the NJIFA Cetrulo Boys' Team Relay Championship is open to all NJIFA member schools.

The entry fee is \$230 per three-weapon team or \$90 per single-weapon squad, if entering less than three weapons. Checks should be made payable to the 'NJIFA' and should accompany this application, which is due December 15. Entries without a faxed seeding form will not be considered.

The format will be a round of preliminary equally-seeded pools followed by a final round of placing pools, which is identical to last season. All weapons will be fenced electrically. All NJIFA rules will be strictly enforced, especially safety rules regarding uniforms, testing with weights and shims and S2000 sabre blades. Arrive on time or you will be barred from the competition. Also, if your team leaves early they will be listed as "did not fence" and your school will be subject to severe sanctions.
