

2010 NJI FA Cetrulo Boys' Relay Championship

Entry to the NJI FA Cetrulo Boys' Team Relay Championship is open to all NJI FA member schools. The entry fee is \$230 per three-weapon team or \$90 per single-weapon squad, if entering less than three weapons. Checks should be made payable to the 'NJI FA' and should be mailed with this application, which is due December 31. Entrants who do not fax a seeding form to the number on that form will not be considered.

The format will be a round of preliminary, equally-weighted seeding pools followed by a final round of placing pools, which is identical to last season. The final 'A' pool will be eight teams. All weapons will be fenced electrically. All NJI FA rules will be strictly enforced, including testing with weights and shims and, especially, safety rules regarding uniforms and S2000 sabre blades. Also, if your team leaves early they will be listed as "did not fence" and your school will be subject to severe sanctions.
