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Instructions for filling out the NJIFA Relays Seeding Forms

Your job as coach is to get your three squads legitimately the highest number of seeding points possible AND to fax this form to **908-838-9012** by **December 31, 2009**. No late forms accepted. Your team cannot compete without a filed seeding form. After filing the form, check the NJIFA's website for a listing of those teams that have filed forms. Coaches will **not** receive individual e-mails confirming receipt.

Points to Remember:

- The order of the fencers and starters versus non-starters is not relevant. Notice that there are no A, B, or C positions. In other words, you don't need to know your starting line-up to fill out this seeding form. Just get the maximum number of seeding points amongst the top 5 or 6 fencers on each squad.
- An unrated USFA fencer gets 0 points, an E gets 1 point, a D gets 2 points, a C gets 3 points and so on up to an A getting 5 points. In addition, each fencer gets 1 seeding point for completing a year of NJ high school fencing. That is, a senior who competes all four years would get a 3 for NJ HS experience. A junior with no NJ high school experience gets no points, just like a freshman.
- The fencer must be present and dressed, ready-to-compete in that weapon on the day of the tournament to give that squad seeding points. If a fencer is on the seeding form, but not attending because of illness or international competitions, the coach must contact the seeding registrar at 973-229-6987, to substitute a fencer who is present.
- Coaches should be able to fill out this form after just a few days of practice. The due date for this form will be **Thursday, December 31**. No late forms will be accepted. Fax the form to the number at the top of the form, **908-838-9012**. Fax this form by itself without a cover sheet to Tom Tishman, seeding registrar.
- Mail the entry form and your school's check or payment voucher to Gail Kedoin, Treasurer. Your squads are not entered until an **entry form is mailed to the Treasurer and a seeding form is faxed to the seeding registrar.**
